ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR LODGE OFFICES

President - Been an active member of the Lodge for at least 6 months immediately preceding the date of election and completed at least 1 year in another elected office (not a combination of offices) of the Lodge in which they seek office

Vice President - Been an active member of the Lodge for at least 6 months immediately preceding the date of election

Chaplain - Been an active member of the Lodge for at least 6 months immediately preceding the date of election

Treasurer - Must be an active member of the Lodge

Trustee - Must be an active member of the Lodge

CAN A MALE BE CONSIDERED FOR CHAPTER
OFFICE?

NO

Males are not eligible to be members of the Chapter,
therefore males cannot be Chapter officers.

Similarly, females are not eligible to be members of the
Moose Legion, therefore females cannot be Moose
Legion officers.
